

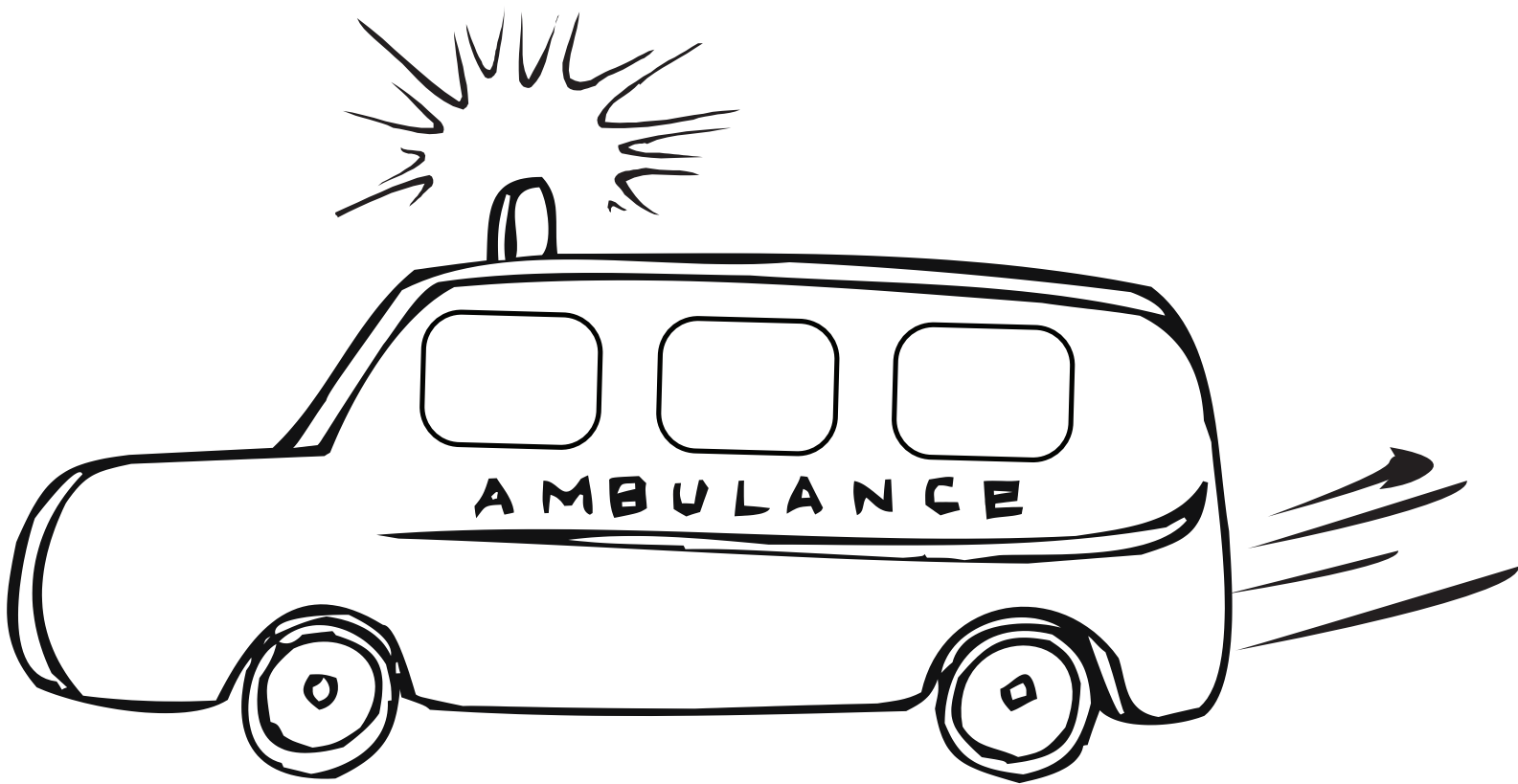

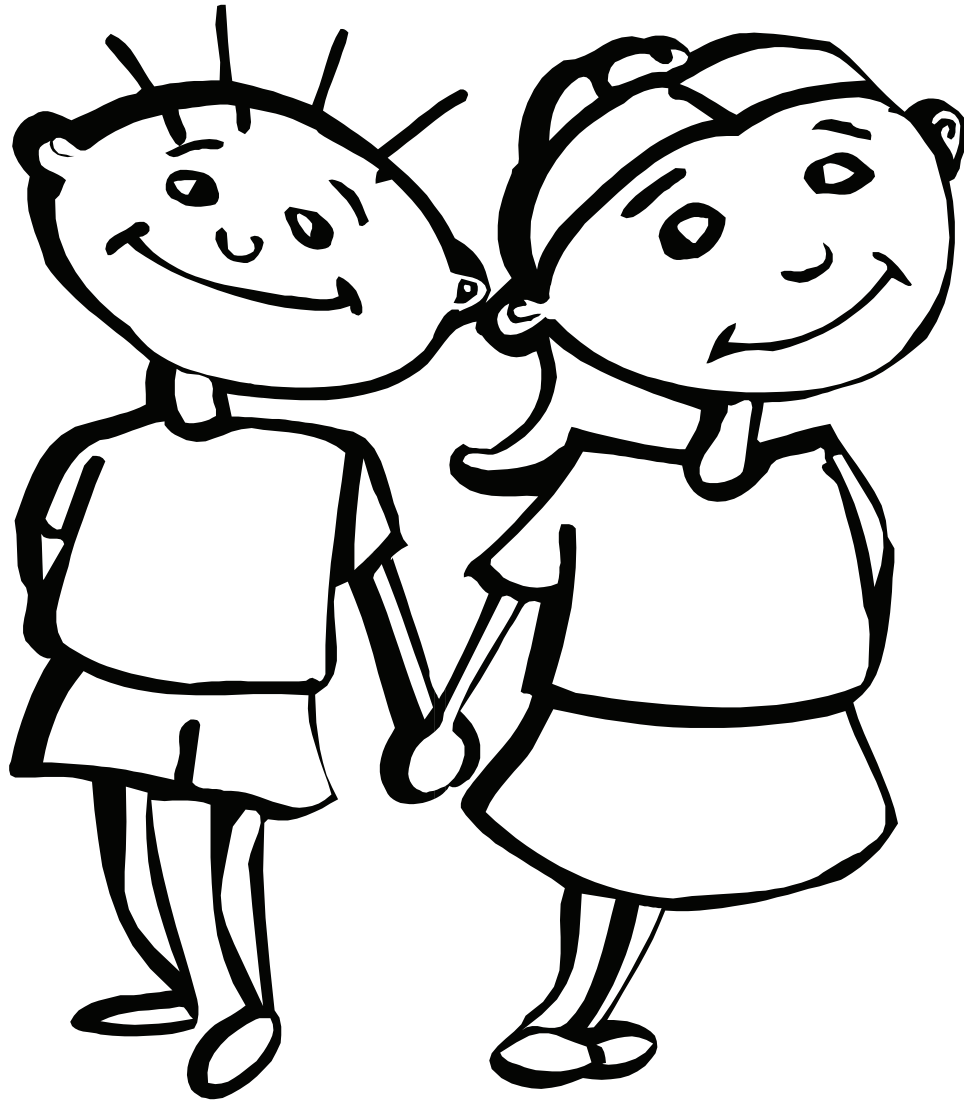


Ambulance



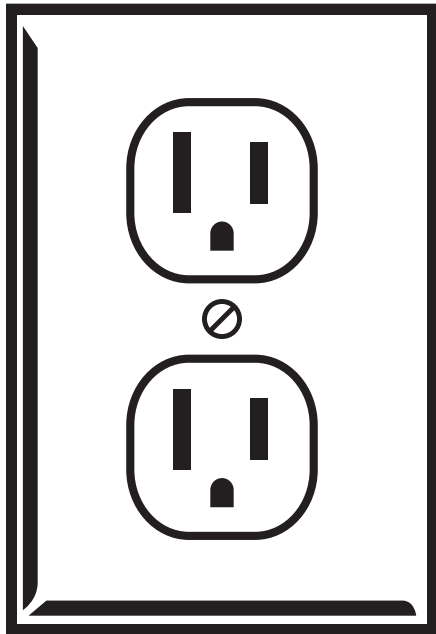
Ambulances save lives. It is good to let them pass in traffic.

Buddy System



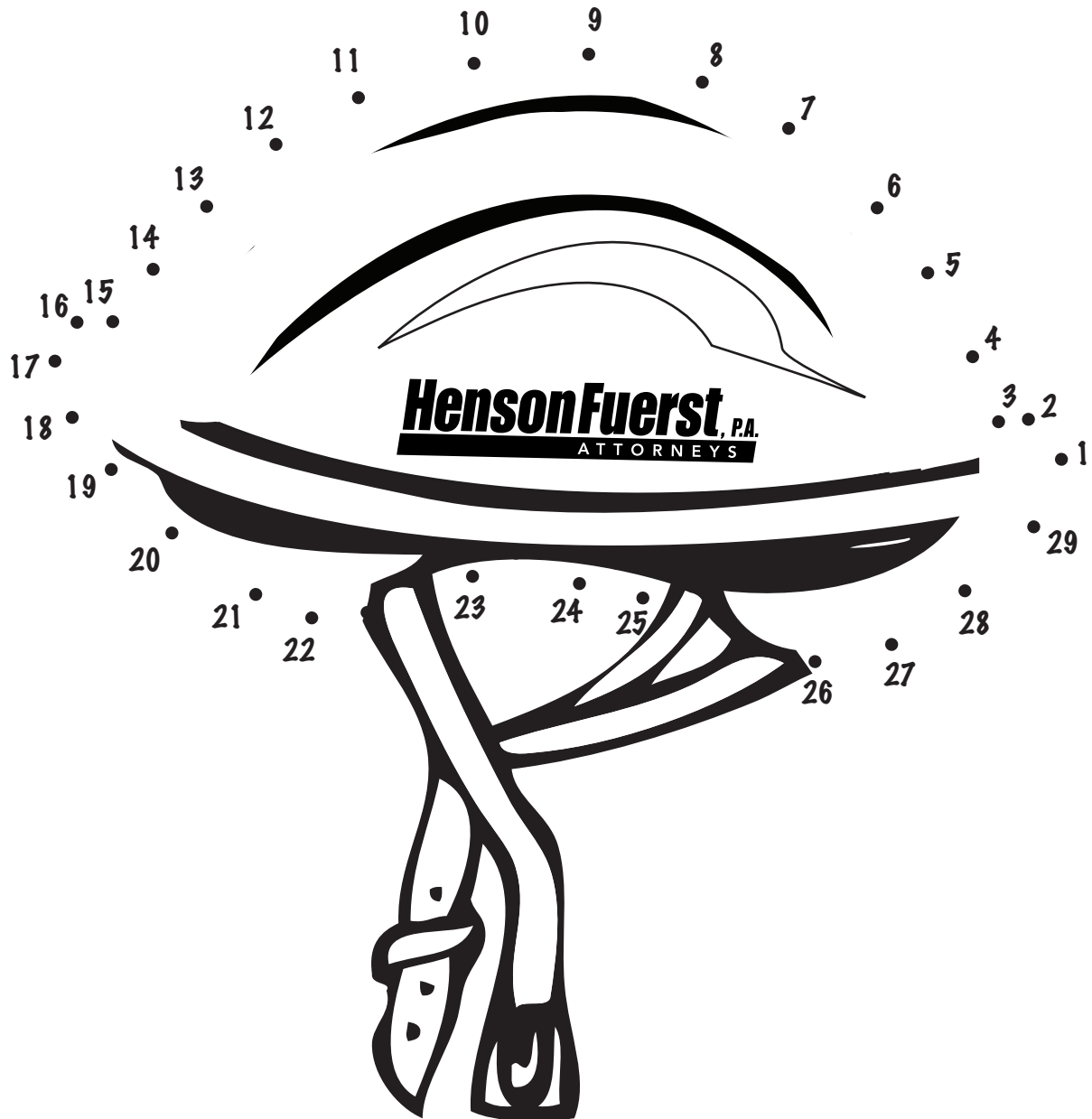
When going to new places, it is always good to have a buddy with you.

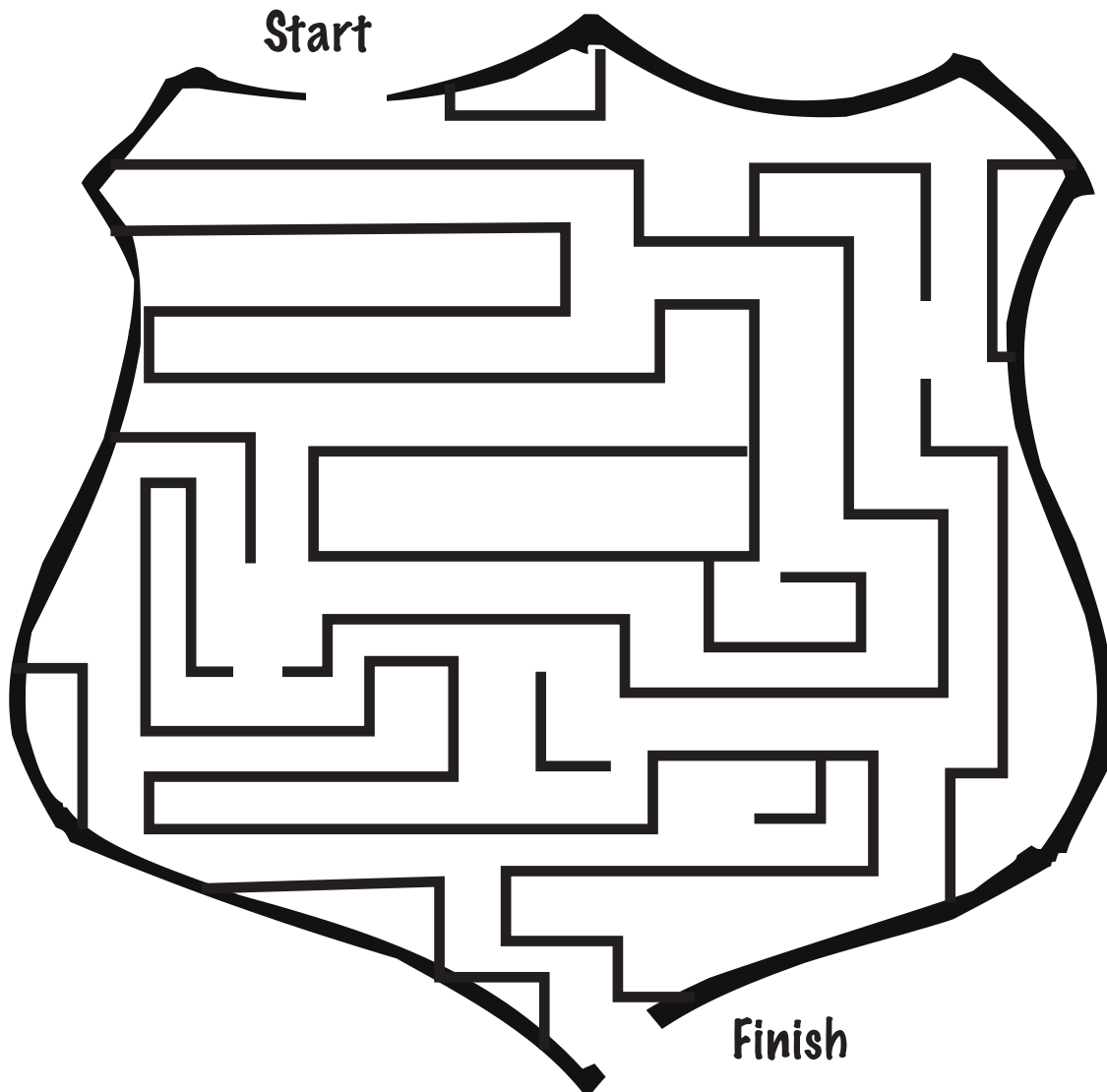

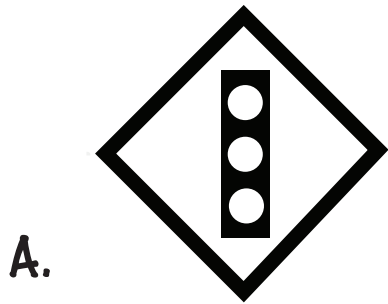

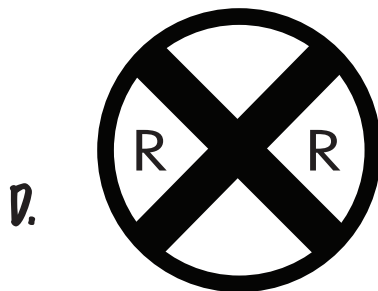

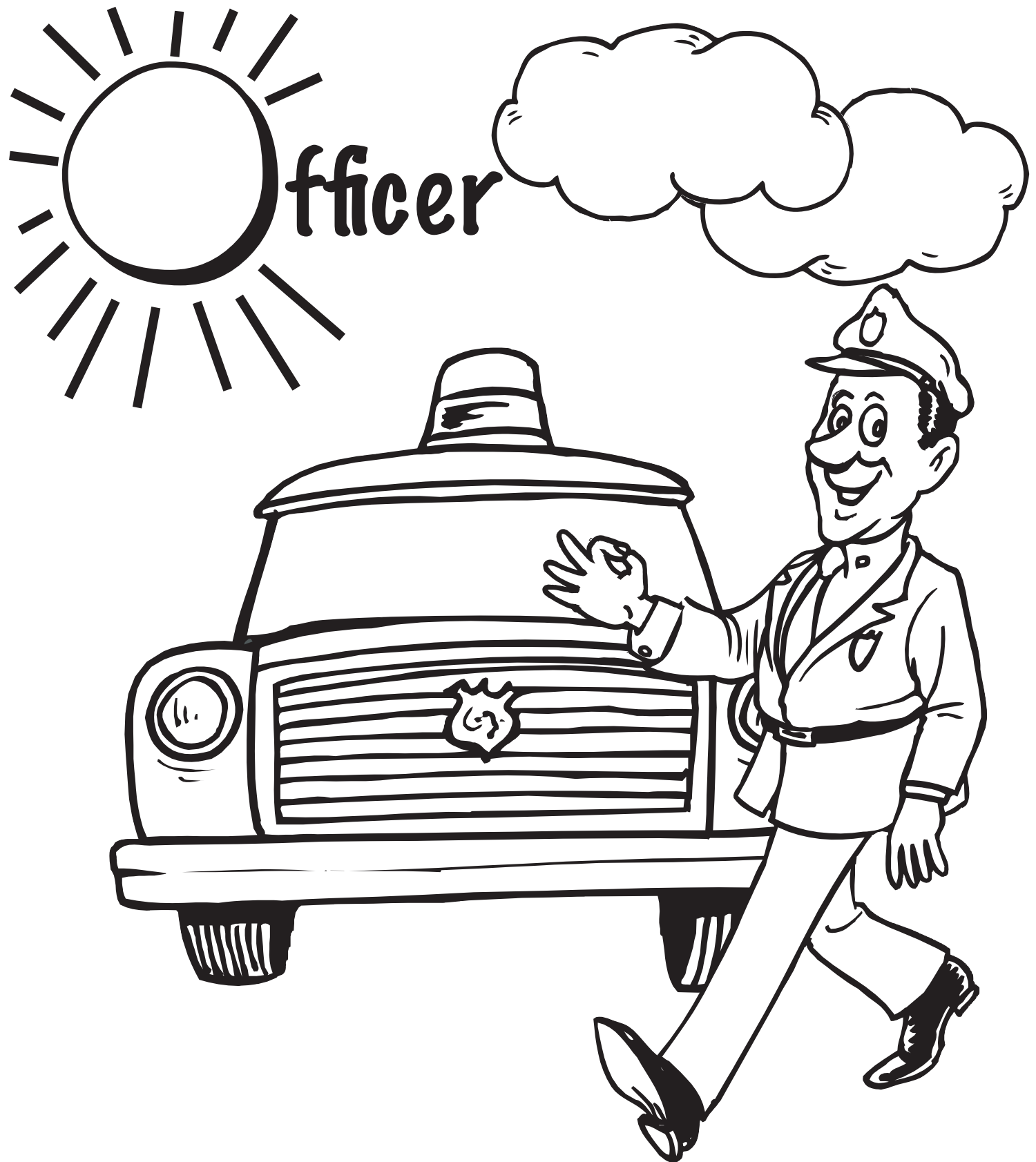






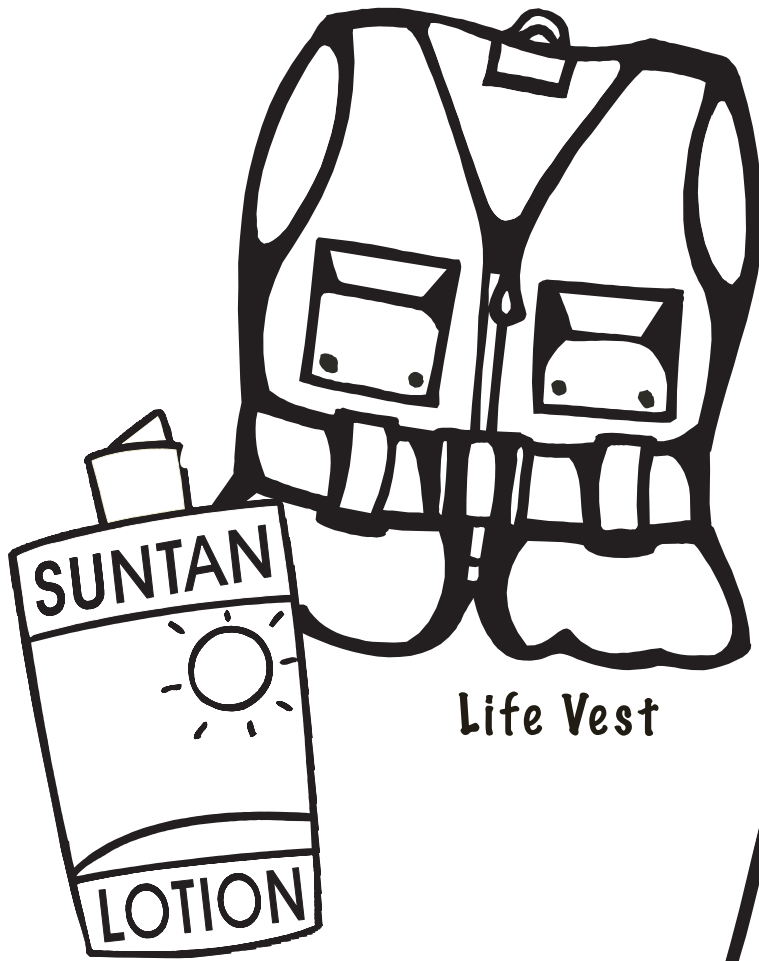
A. Traffic Light B. Stop Sign C. Slip Road D. Railroad Crossing E. Crosswalk F. Bicycle Route

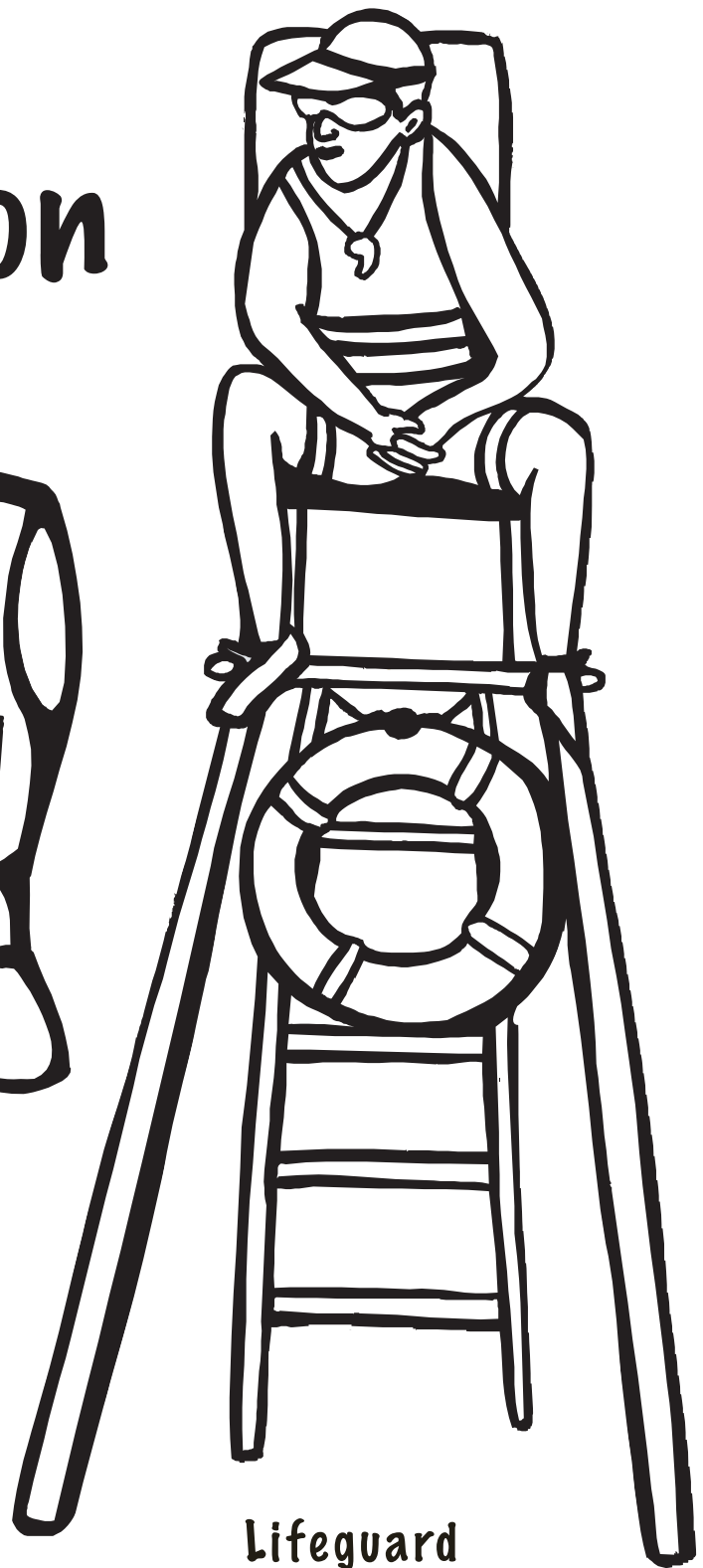

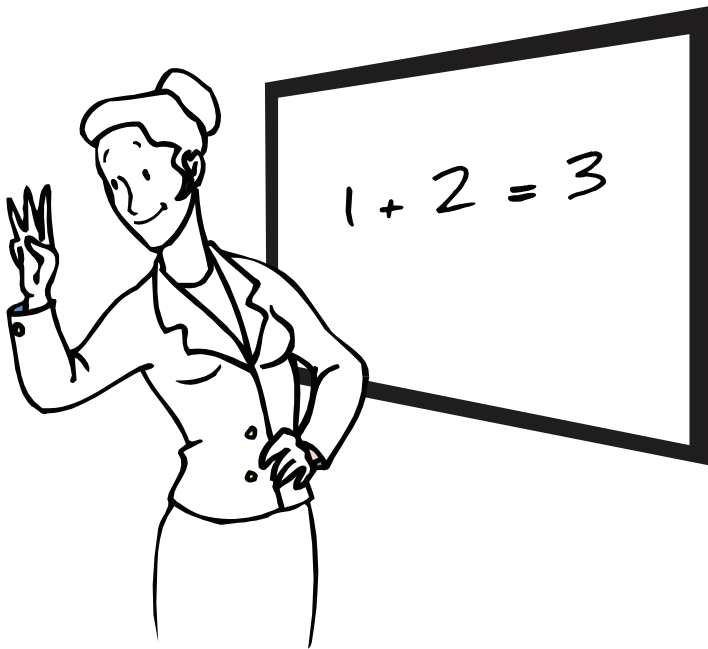
When having fun in the sun, these can be used to protect you from harm!

- 9) Never run or play rough around a swimming pool.

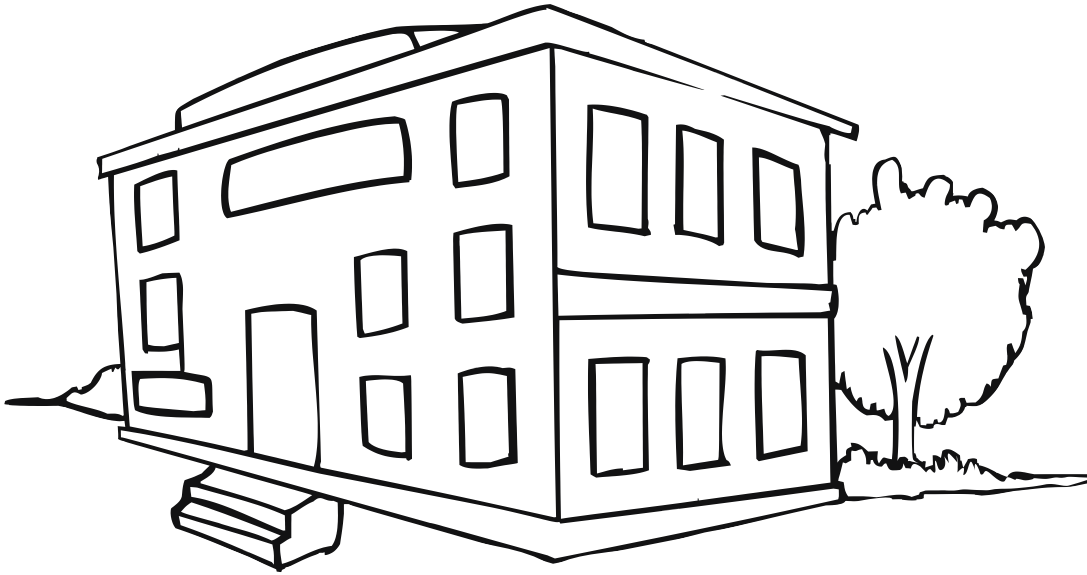
